# A Message from the Rector

April 2016

Alleluia! Jesus is risen! He is risen indeed!

This is my second year celebrating Easter with you at Transfiguration, and I'm overjoyed by the positive changes in our church. Since July 2014, when Cathleen and I arrived in Evergreen, we've seen a tremendous transformation. For instance:

- Our congregation has grown by roughly 54 new members.
- The previously non-existent Youth Group now has 12 participants with regular attendance on Mission Trips, retreats and at bi-monthly meetings. We've also hired a Youth Minister!
- JAM (Jesus And Me) engages the middle and high school youth during the 10: 15 am Sunday Eucharist.
- The enrollment for Sunday School has increased so much that and we are in need of another classroom and are developing a nursery.
- The ECW and DOK have been resurrected, with renewed fellowship among the women of the church. This large group has already got a full schedule of events planned!
- We've launched the Transfiguration Outreach Ministry (TOM). Just two of their current projects are working more closely with EChO and collaborating with Severe Weather Evergreen Emergency Providing Shelter (SWEEPS) in assisting the homeless of Evergreen.
- Our new Prayer Shawl Ministry hand-crafts beautiful afghans to comfort the sick.
- We've initiated a Pastoral Care Team, reaching out to the sick, homebound and those in need of support.

You may not realize it, but these are all ministries! They feed us spiritually. We develop relationships and friendships. We begin to care about one another. We offer ourselves in kindness. This "ministering" helps to create a family and as you can see, our family is growing! Just as Jesus was resurrected, we've begun to resurrect the Church of the Transfiguration! We are spreading the Good News!

There are many more ways that our church family can flourish, but I'm delighted with these successes! The ministerial achievements of our church family make my spirits soar!

Alleluia! Jesus is risen! He is risen indeed!

The Outreach team selected the second Sunday of each month as "Outreach Sunday" and church members are asked to donate a different item every month, with the articles being given to EChO. Additionally, many parish volunteers continue to make soup (and salads during the summer months) for EChO.

Transfiguration has begun partnering with a number of local organizations addressing the needs of the homeless on cold nights. The Severe Weather Evergreen Emergency Providing Shelter (SWEEPS) was launched and thirteen members of Transfiguration have completed the required training. The feasibility of the program was proven with a successful test run!

When Marcia Walsh, one of our long-time parishioners learned about the challenges facing refugees, she didn't hesitate to get involved. CoT is now collaborating with Lutheran Family Services to aid refugees from around the world. Six volunteers from Transfiguration are in the process of concluding the mandatory education for this worthwhile endeavor.

Another member, Susie Williams initiated church participation in the Matthew 25 Project. Since October 2015, Transfiguration has shipped over 360 empty medicine bottles to locations throughout the world where supplies are low or non-existent.

Plans are in the works for a USO Swing Dance party on June 25 with the proceeds benefiting Veterans' causes. This project will take tremendous effort, and has the potential to be a huge success, but only with the help of many volunteers.

Supporting, providing, contributing, caring for and aiding the disadvantaged are objectives of the Transfiguration Outreach Ministry. Although much has been accomplished, fresh ideas and enthusiasm are necessary for this ministry to thrive. If you have a concept for a new project or just want to get involved, contact the Outreach team.

We are all called to love God and our neighbors. As Christians, we are obligated to aid the less fortunate. As parishioners, it is our duty and privilege to help the needy within our community and beyond. We all feel better when we've done something nice for someone, so please consider volunteering with the Transfiguration Outreach Ministry.
