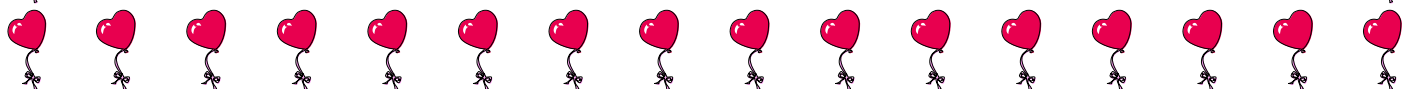
Want to be an acolyte?! Already an acolyte but want to be a server? Want to brush up on server duties and make sure we are all on the same page?

Ham Salad for Fifty!

- Four pounds ham, cooked and coarsely ground
- Six hard boiled eggs, chopped
- Two onions, chopped

Dressing:

- One and one-fourth cups sour cream
- One and one-fourth cups mayonnaise
- Eight ounces pickle relish



Combine ham, eggs and onions

Combine sour cream, mayonnaise, and pickle relish

Pour dressing over ham mixture, being careful not to have too much.

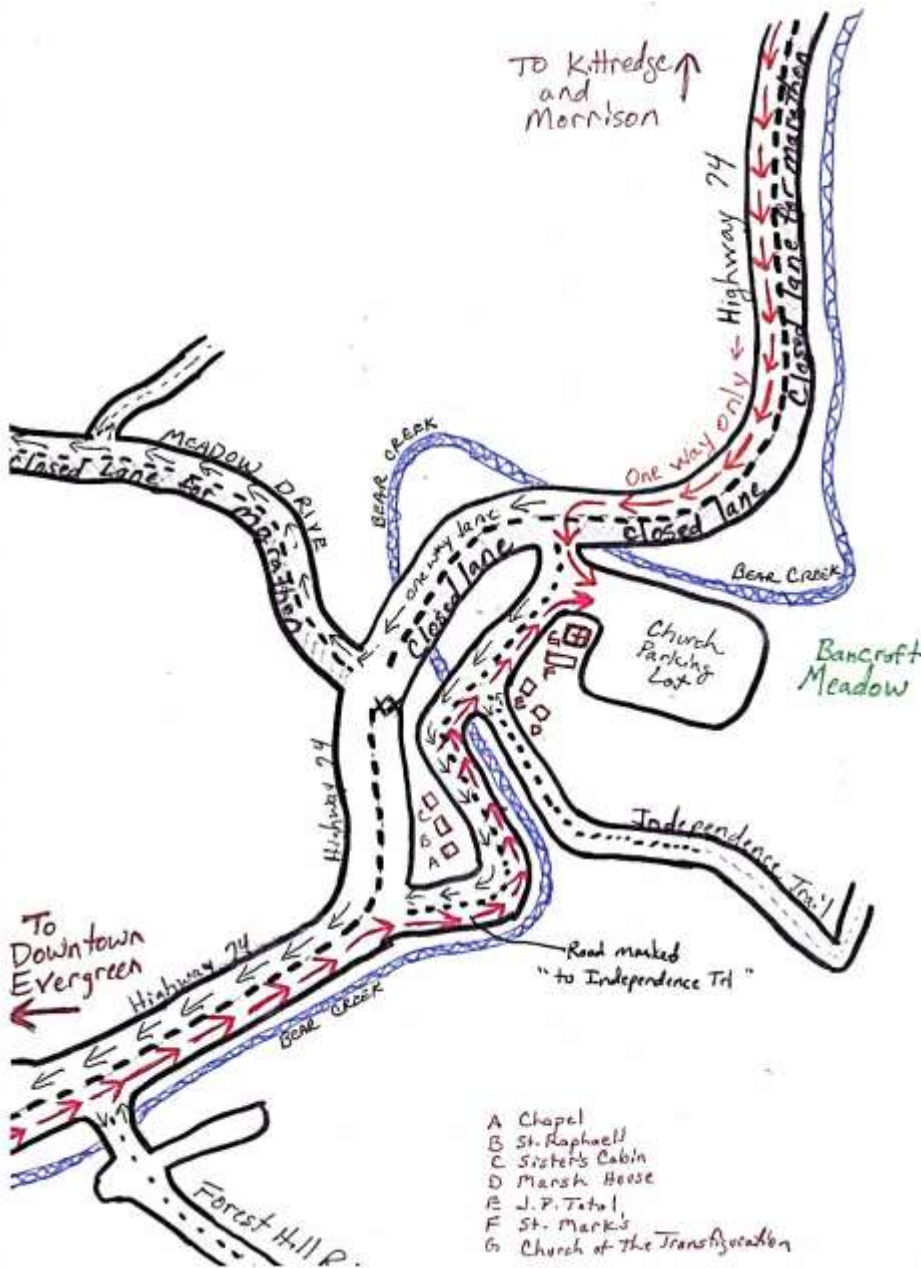
SUNDAY, AUGUST 17, 2014 ROAD/ LANE CLOSURES

AFFECTING TRAFFIC TO CHURCH

On Sunday, August 17, 2014, the Revel half and full marathon will be taking place in Evergreen. The subsequent road/lane closures will affect everyone's travel to church, whether you go to the 8:00am or 10:15am service.

Highway 74, from Morrison to Meadow Drive in Evergreen will only have one lane open and only westward (Morrison to Evergreen direction). Meadow Drive, if opened at all, will also be one lane only going west or north (going away from church).

This means anyone coming from Evergreen, west of Meadow Drive, will not be able to reach the church through the main entrance. The only way to reach the church from that direction will be to come through downtown and take the back way by St. Raphael's, past J.P. Total, into our parking lot. (The road to the right marked "To Independence Trl" at the very end of downtown Evergreen.)



If you come to church from Kittredge, Indian Hills, or Morrison, you can still come up the canyon on highway 74, but it will probably be slow traffic with the marathon going on in the opposite lane.

Anyone coming from Kittredge, Indian Hills, or Morrison who go to the 8:00am service, will not be able to back home the same way unless you wait until the roads are open again. Unfortunately, I do not know when that might happen.

Most likely the roads will be back to normal after the 10:15 service, though that is not guaranteed.

Please be sure to plan your travel to and from church carefully on Sunday, August 17th!

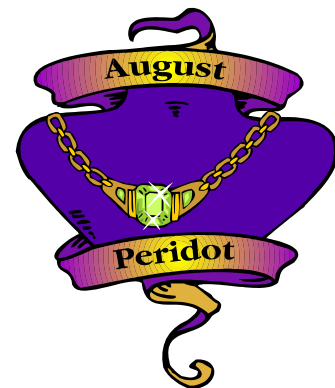

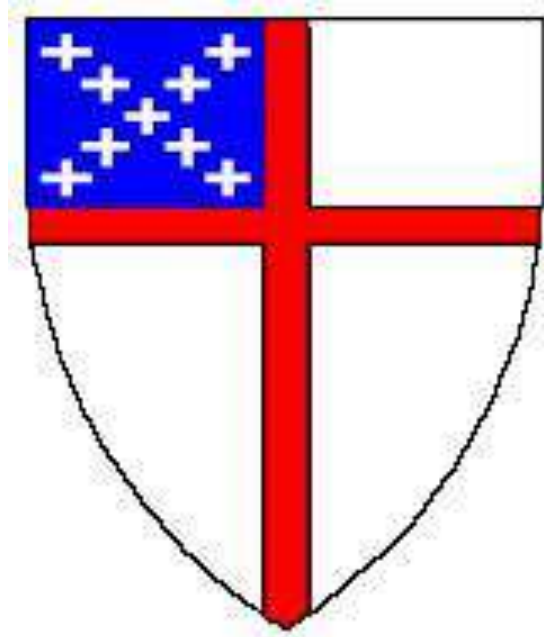
