A Message from the Rector

With Thanksgiving approaching, November is the perfect time of year to discuss Stewardship. We are making plans to be with family and friends. We collectively open our hearts and often invite those who would otherwise be alone to share the holiday. We give thanks for God's blessings.

Similarly, Stewardship is about thanksgiving. It is a way we can thank God by helping others. It is our "personal outreach."
