# A Message from the Rector

Years ago, Cathleen and I were at the beach with our young children, Charles and Elizabeth. We were building a sandcastle and while we were engrossed in digging and sculpting, an older gentleman walked by. He spoke to us briefly about our beautiful family. I remember how happy he was to see our little family playing together on the beach. He was so full of joy!

South Florida has many retirees, and quite often their children and grandchildren live far away. At the grocery store, elderly strangers would see the kids and stop to say hello. Charles always responded with a cheerful, "Hi, I'm Charlie! This is my Daddy, Michael!" The reaction was always one of joy!

The story of the Road to Emmaus, (Luke 24:13-35) reminds me of the gentleman on the beach and the customers in the grocery store. Two disciples were leaving Jerusalem. They were sad because Jesus, their friend, teacher and spiritual leader had been put to death. They had decided to call it quits and head home, back to their old lives.

While journeying from Jerusalem to Emmaus, they were joined by a stranger. He listened as the disciples described their sadness about the loss of Jesus. The man spoke of the scriptures which foretold that Jesus must suffer and die in order to resurrect. The stranger was teaching them that their journey with Christ would continue if they opened their minds to the scriptures.

Upon reaching Emmaus, the stranger was encouraged to share a meal, then rest for the night. When they broke bread, the disciples finally discovered that their companion was Jesus. Suddenly, Jesus disappeared. The disciples realized that during the journey with the stranger and by opening their minds to the scriptures, they had experienced the teaching of the risen Lord. They were full of joy!

This story brings home the idea that we are all on a journey. Sometimes we walk with Jesus. At other times we walk away from Jesus. Occasionally, we recognize Jesus on our journey, but most often we are blinded by our preoccupations. At times, it may seem he has disappeared. No matter. We may not realize it, but Jesus is always walking with us. We are his current disciples.

Every now and then we are aware of the One who is walking with us. It is then that we experience the joy of knowing the Lord. The more we become aware of the Lord who journeys with us, the more likely we will experience the fullness of his joy.

Seek the Lord and he will be found. Call upon him and he will come near.
