## A Message from the Rector

We celebrated Pentecost on Sunday, June 4. Pentecost is the coming of the Holy Spirit among the apostles and followers of Jesus. Celebrated 50 days after Easter, the name of this holiday comes from the Greek Pentēkostē, which literally means "the 50th day."

The day of Pentecost is identified by the Book of Common Prayer (p. 312) as one of the feast days "especially appropriate" for baptism. Thus, it was fitting that we celebrated the baptism of Weston Caldwell on the feast of Pentecost.

Pentecost is also known as "Whitsun" or "Whitsunday" ("White Sunday"), a term used to describe the white baptismal garments worn by those who were baptized at the Vigil of Pentecost and then worn to church on the Day of Pentecost. Weston wore white and received a white candle symbolizing his baptism by the Holy Spirit.

At our Meadow service on June 11th at 9:30 am, we will celebrate Trinity Sunday. Thereafter, we will celebrate 22 more Sundays in the season of Pentecost.

Pentecost is the inauguration of the Church's mission in the world. Empowered by the gift of the Holy Spirit, we are sent out into the world, as witnesses to the risen Christ.
