A Message from the Rector

I hope you're enjoying the summer! Summer is a good time to re-connect with our extended families and friends. We have the opportunity to share memories of the good and bad times we've experienced together. A chance to catch up with loved ones.

In June, Cathleen and I traveled to Pennsylvania for the wedding of our niece, Amanda and her new husband, Lou. The reception was held in a beautiful, sylvan park and was the perfect setting for a large gathering. It was a gorgeous, sun-filled day with parents, brothers, sisters, nieces, nephews, in-laws and little ones.

During the afternoon, one of our nephews-in-law took me aside and said he wanted to "talk shop." He explained his philosophy of life, how we all have animal instincts of surviving, procreating and working hard to support our families.
