A Message from the Rector

September is always a busy month and fitting everything in to your schedule can certainly be a challenge. I know life can be hectic, but I thought you might be interested in learning about the some new ministries that are emerging here at Transfiguration.

Several of you have requested a Bible Study program, so starting on September 14, at 6:00 pm, Robin Tems and I will lead a class with the focus on the Gospels. No previous biblical experience is required and any Bible will do. Be prepared for a lively discussion!

After many years of hiatus, the Stephen Ministry will be resurrected. A Stephen Minister is someone who walks with you as Christ does, helping you deal with the hardships in life. Morris Burnham and Michelle O'Laughlin are exploring the merits of becoming Stephen Ministers and we hope to have this program up and running this fall.

The EDSE resumed in late August and we've begun a Children's Chapel service every Thursday at 2:30 pm in the church. In this way are able to connect our church with the children, parents and staff of the preschool. More importantly, it will expose the little ones to the love of Christ.

On August 28th, JAM (Jesus and Me), an educational program for Middle and High School youth resumed. Clay Sumner and Stephanie Park lead the youth every other Sunday during the 10:15 am service when they discuss the readings with the youth. At the end of September the youth will attend the fall Quest Retreat.

Thankfully, our church strongly supports the Youth Group, but adult leaders are vital for its continued growth. The youth are the future of our church, therefore we, as adults must help them on their journey toward Christ. We need parents, grandparents and adults to take a more active role in maintaining the momentum of our Youth Group. If we don't have more adults willing to help, the program will fail. Please consider working with our youth—they are really great young people!

Finally, Rally Day is September 11. It's an opportunity for you to find a ministry that suits your interests. The leaders of each parish ministry will be on hand to answer questions and invite you to learn about and become more involved at Transfiguration.
