# The Season of Advent

The word Advent means "coming" or "arrival." The focus of the entire season is the celebration of the birth of Jesus the Christ in his First Advent, and the anticipation of the return of Christ the King in his Second Advent. Thus, Advent is far more than simply mark-

ing a 2,000 year old event in history. It is celebrating a truth about God, the revelation of God in Christ whereby all of creation might be reconciled to God. That is a process in which we now participate, and the consummation of which we anticipate. Scripture reading

for Advent will reflect this emphasis on the Second Advent, including themes of accountability for faithfulness at His coming, judgment on sin, and the hope of eternal life.

In this double focus on past and future, Advent also symbolizes the spiritual journey of

individuals and a congregation, as they affirm that Christ has come, that He is present in the world today, and that He will come again in power. That acknowledgment provides a basis for Kingdom ethics, for holy living arising from a profound sense that we live "between the times" and are called to be faithful stewards of what is entrusted to us as God's people. So, as the church celebrates God's inbreaking into history in the Incarnation, and anticipates a future consummation to that history for which "all creation is groaning awaiting its redemption," it also confesses its own responsibility as a people commissioned to "love the Lord your God with all your heart" and to "love your neighbor as yourself."

Advent is one of the few Christian festivals that can be observed in the home as well as at church. In its association with Christmas, Advent is a natural time to involve children in activities at home that directly connect with worship at church. In the home an Advent wreath is often placed on the dining table and the candles lighted at meals, with Scripture readings preceding the lighting of the candles, especially on Sunday. A new candle is lighted each Sunday during the four weeks, and then the same candles are lighted each meal during the week. In this context, it provides the opportunity for family devotion and prayer together, and

helps teach the Faith to children, especially if they are involved in reading the daily Scriptures.




#### **Soup Ministry**

#### CHRISTMAS SOUP

In large pot or Dutch oven, heat to boiling: 4 cups water, 4 chicken bouillon cubes; add rest of ingredients and cook until rice is done.

- 1 (16 oz.) can red kidney beans (undrained)
- 1 (8 oz.) can tomato sauce
- 3 tbsp.. chili sauce
- 1 c. diced turkey ham
- 1 c. white rice
- 1 c. diced celery
- 1/2 c. diced green peppers
- 1 bunch chopped green onions
- 1 tbsp. parsley
- 4 chicken bouillon cubes






