




Turkey Cranberry Stew

pound turkey breast, cooked and shredded
 ounces fresh cranberries
 yellow onion, sliced thin
 cup corn
 ounces mushrooms, sliced
 cups turkey stock
 cup dry white wine
 Tbsp fresh thyme
 tbsp honey
 tbsp butter
 Salt and pepper




Sauté onions in butter about five minutes. Add mushrooms and corn and cook another ten minutes . Add wine. Scrape pan to loosen cartelized bits. Add stock, turkey, cranberries, honey and thyme. Bring to a boil. Reduce to simmer, cook 15 minutes. Add beans and cook 10 minutes more.


