



God's Mutual Call

An interesting thing happened to my wife and I last month. I received a call from the Church of the Transfiguration in Evergreen, Colorado to become the Rector beginning on July 1, 2014. Naturally, we were thrilled and immediately accepted this call!

What you may not realize is that you too have been called. It is clear that God calls each of us into community just as certain as Jesus called each of his disciples by name. In my experience, it seems that God is constantly calling us into a variety of new ministries.

At the same time, God calls every one of us to be ministers in our own church community.

One of my professors explained the call to ministry this way: God **said**, "There is a man named Michael whom I will call to join a wife in marriage, into having children and into a certain profession. After many years, I will call Michael and his wife to move to Colorado and join the family of the Church of the Transfiguration. I will make this call

because the gifts of both Michael and his wife are needed in my community at this church. God saw that **it was good.**"

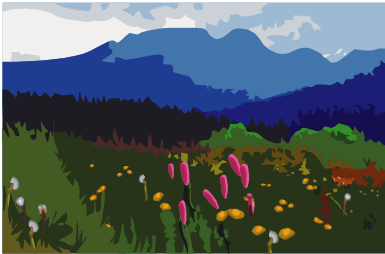
Services in the Meadow

in Douglas Hall on these Sundays.

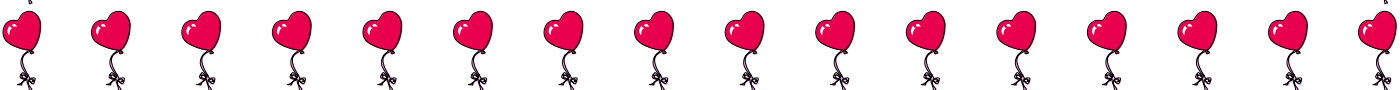

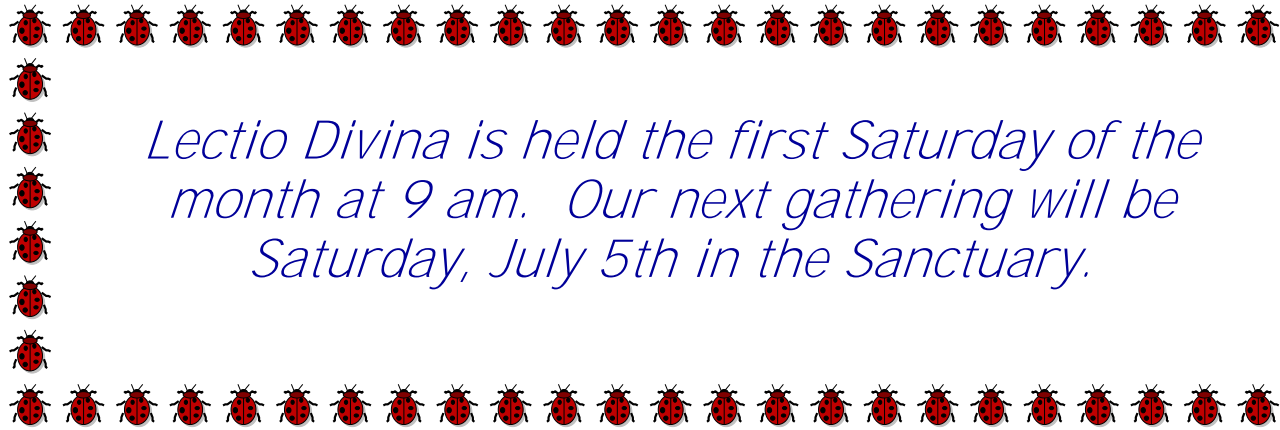

Stephanie's Crunchy Squash Casserole

- Yellow squash—5 or 6
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 T. butter, melted
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1 can (8 oz) water chestnuts, drained
- 1 package (6 oz) chicken flavored stuffing mix
- 1/4 cup plus 2 T. butter, melted



Cook squash, drain well. Saute onion in 1 T. butter. Combine squash, onion, sour cream, soup and water chestnuts. In a separate bowl, combine stuffing mix and remaining melted butter, stir well. Add 3/4 of stuffing mix to squash mixture, spoon into a 2-quart casserole. Sprinkle remaining stuffing mix over casserole. Bake at 350 for 20 minutes or until bubbly.

(hint—I never measure the butter or sour cream, but I do use the low fat versions of everything!)

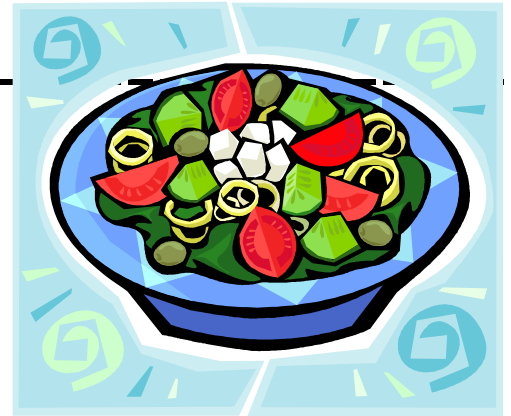


Soup Ministry

Homemade soups in the freezer are available for parishioners and friends that are sick, shut-in or need some TLC. Feel free to give soup to someone you see at church that is hurting, or take soup to someone you are going to visit. The soups are in the freezer on the east wall of the kitchen.

Tuna Pesto Salad

- 1/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1 (3-ounce) jar pesto
- 1/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1 (12-ounce) can tuna in water, drained
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- 1 cup frozen baby peas, thawed
- 8 (8-inch) flour tortillas
- 8 leaves lettuce



In medium bowl, combine mayonnaise, pesto, Parmesan cheese, lemon juice, garlic, and pepper. Gently mix in tuna, red bell pepper, and baby peas. At this point you can cover the mixture and refrigerate it for 2-3 days.

When ready to serve, add cherry tomatoes. Layer the tortillas with lettuce and add tuna mixture;

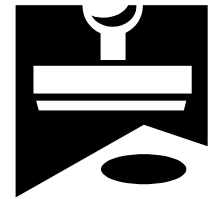
