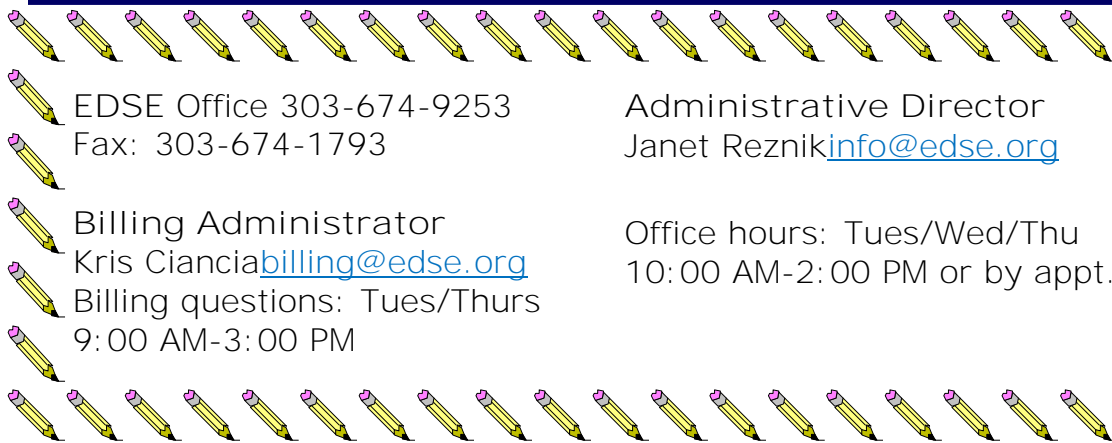
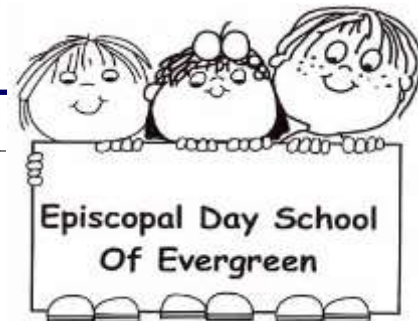

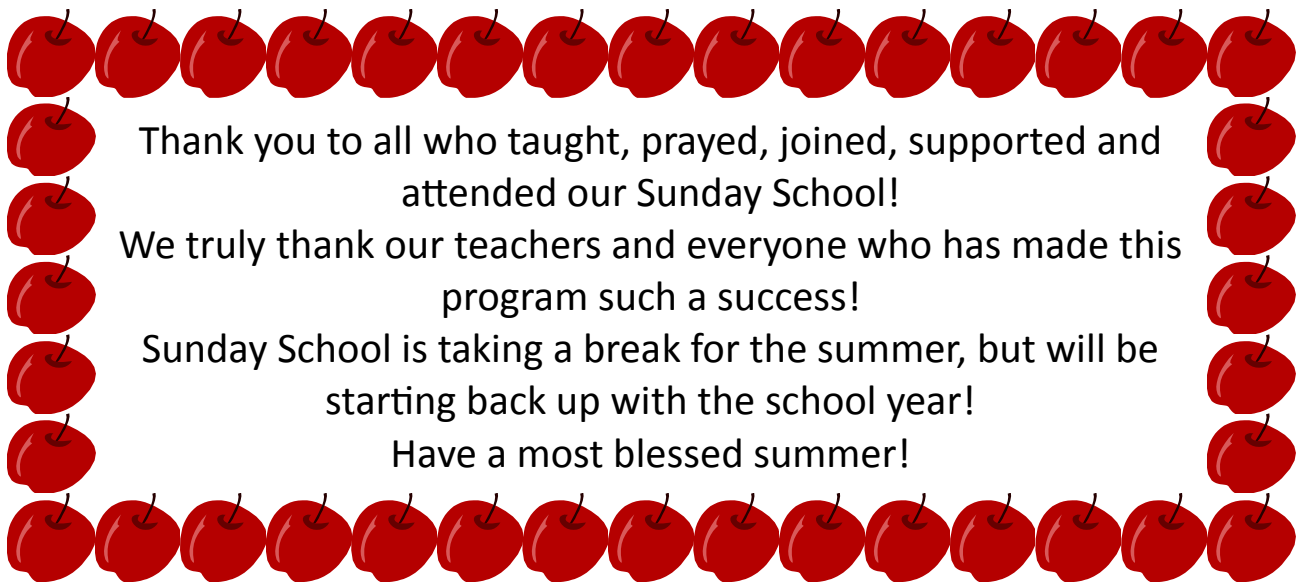

## ***Tuna Salad***

- Two 6-ounce cans white meat tuna packed in water, drained**
- 2 tablespoons minced celery**
- 2 tablespoons minced red onion, soaked in cold water for 5 minutes and drained**
- 1 teaspoon minced flat-leaf parsley**
- 1/3 cup prepared mayonnaise**
- 1 tablespoon whole-grain mustard**
- Freshly ground black pepper**
- Freshly squeezed lemon juice**

In a small mixing bowl break up the tuna with a fork. Toss with the celery, onion, and parsley. Add the mayonnaise, mustard and season with pepper, to taste. Stir to combine. Add lemon juice, to taste, if using.

Cook's note: Substitute 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard for the whole-grain mustard and add 2 tablespoons sweet pickle relish
